

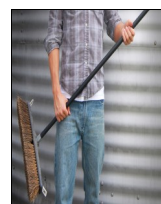
Registrations are now being taken in the church office. We are still needing volunteers. If you would like to help, please contact Bryan Proctor.
