First Baptist Church we offer a number of opportunities for corporate worship with fellow believers. Our services are traditional with newer elements blended in as appropriate.

On each Sunday, three worship services are held: 8:30 am, 10:50 am following Sunday school, and 6:00 pm. A worship choir usually fills the choir loft at the 10:50 service. Once a quarter the entire evening service is conducted by our senior high and junior high youth groups.

Special music is always provided by soloists and ensembles singing a variety of inspirational songs ranging from traditional to contemporary, with some gospel and even country included. A youth "signing and theme interpretation" group also periodically blesses our worship times.

Wednesday evenings at 6:30 are devoted to corporate prayer. This coincides with all of the Wednesday night children, youth, and adult discipleship activities.

We offer a nursery for all worship services and have special activities for children ages 18 months to 4 years. *We have a well-trained staff of volunteers to care for your child in a safe and nurturing environment.*

At First Baptist Church, we love your children! Dana Royalty, our Children's minister, and Molly Davis, our Pre-School Coordinator, work very closely with all of our volunteer teachers and program directors to create a loving, nurturing, and safe environment for your child. We offer something special for all children, birth to sixth grade, including a fully-staffed nursery, age appropriate Sunday school, weekly AWANA, choir, and missions programs, and seasonal activities such as Summer JAM. AWANA (*Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed*) is for children age 18 months through 6th grade and is held every Sunday evening from 5:30 until 7:15 during the school year. The primary goal of AWANA is to reach boys and girls with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to train them to serve Him. This is taught through memorizing key verses of Scripture, counsel time messages, and fellowship.

We offer Sunday school for children from birth through 6th grade. Sunday school begins at 9:45 am and ends by 10:30 am. Each class is specially tailored to meet the needs of the specific age group. Age appropriate activities include Bible study, crafts, center activities, and music. All classes meet in our Children's Building.

G-Force is our Sunday morning worship service for kids age 1st through 5th grade that meets during our 10:50 worship service. Using skits, music, video and games, kids are taught the truth of God's Word and how to apply it their life. Children age 4 through 6th grade are dismissed immediately following Pastor and Lambs. We also have separate toddler worship services for 2s / 3s and 4s / 5s that meet during the 10:50 worship service. Through the use of skits, stories, music, and puppets, the children learn about God and Jesus in a fun, interactive setting. 2s and 3s go directly to toddler worship after Sunday School.



Our choir and hand bell groups offer children the opportunity to grow and express themselves musically and dramatically. These groups have several opportunities to use their talents throughout the year in worship and special musical events such as our annual Christmas musical. We offer three choirs for children ages 18 months through 5th grade that meet Wednesday evenings from 6:45 to 7:30.



Our children's mission groups meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 – 6:45 during the school year in the children's room. Our Kids on Mission program is designed to train kids to lead a missions lifestyle in their home, school, community, and beyond! We not only teach them about missions, we pray for our missionaries all over the world, give to missions, and do monthly mission projects. Every week, we begin in the children's room in the CLC for a group discussion and then break into smaller groups by age—Mission Friends, Girls in Action, and Royal Ambassadors. Each month we complete a group mission project.



Upward basketball and cheerleading present us with the opportunity to share the Gospel of Christ to children and their families in a safe and fun environment. Every child wants to feel like a winner. In Upward, every child is a winner! We teach character, integrity, and positive concepts found in God's world to relay God's message on the basketball court. Upward doesn't change lives. We are simply using it to introduce children to the One who does!
