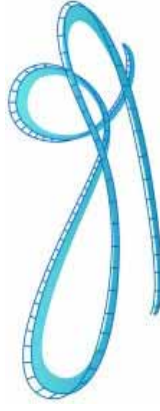

### MOPPETS

Free child care is provided at MOPS meetings for babies through six year olds. They will do a bible lesson, a craft, watch a short video, have a snack and play outside or in the gym.
